Creating an environment where residents feel at home and safe was the primary objective for Thomson Adsett Architect, Lydia Chandrasekera when designing Stage 1 of the new Mercy Place Montrose. Set in the foothills of the Dandenong Ranges, Stage 1 provides a 90 bed Aged Care facility configured in 12 separate 'households' each containing seven or eight beds. A specialist in aged care, Lydia specified Gerflor flooring and other finishes to reflect the trends strengthening in this sector.

"The main thing is to deliver facilities of a domestic scale that feel like home - not a hospitality or hotel setting, not an institution - home. Mercy Health wants its facilities to be as homelike as possible.
